GUIDES FOR CANDIDATES

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATE

1. The candidate is expected to record all the procedures in which he/she involved in this logbook according to the daily roster
2. This logbook is valid for the duration stated on the front page
3. The logbook should be submitted every three (3) months
4. The candidate is expected to report at least 100 cases of plain radiography per week

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the posting, the candidate should be able to:

1. perform most of the diagnostic radiological procedures without supervision
2. perform some interventional procedures with minimal supervision (e.g. stenting, nephrostomy, PTBD, drainage)
3. assist more complicated interventional procedures (e.g. TACE, radiofrequency ablation, embolization)
4. identify, analyses and conclude the findings in all radiological cases upon completion of the report
5. decide the need for further radiological examination or procedure
6. chair the clinical-radiological conference
7. lead his/her team to accomplish tasks and utilize the resources, productive and cost-effectively
8. exhibit good communication and interpersonal relationship skills with patients, radiology colleagues, radiologists and referring doctors

GUIDES FOR CANDIDATES

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

Dissertation

1. Report writing should be done within 1st 3 months of Year 4
2. Submission of the report to the supervisor should be done by the 5th month of Year 4
3. The final draft should be submitted to the PG office 6 months before the exit examination
4. The manuscript should be sent for publication or presented at any medical conferences

Conference presentation

The students should present (either oral or poster) at any medical conferences
