Guide to candidates

INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATE

- 1. The logbook is valid for the duration stated
- 2. The logbook should be submitted every three (3) months
- 3. Target to report minimum 50 plain radiograph per week

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the posting, the candidates are expected to: -

- 1. perform simple diagnostic procedures without supervision
- 2. perform more complicated/invasive procedure with minimal supervision
- 3. assist interventional procedure under close supervision
- 4. identify, describe those abnormal radiograph findings, perform analysis on findings to reach the diagnosis and prepare a written report
- 5. make a good decision upon radiological management
- 6. actively participate in the clinical-radiological conference
- 7. exhibit good verbal and non-verbal communication with patients, radiology colleagues, radiologists and referring doctors



Guide to candidates

WHER REQUIREMENTS

Case report:-

- ONE (1) case report should be submitted for publication every six
 (6) month
- A total of **THREE (3)** cases must be submitted SIX (6) months prior to professional examination
- All case reports MUST be **submitted to journal** for publication

Dissertation:-

- The students MUST submit the dissertation proposal to the **ethic committee** as a pre-requisite for a professional examination.
- The students need to fill up a **dissertation progress** form every 6 months
